The UG Light Vehicle Journeyman Mechanic is responsible for the inspection, maintenance, and repair of underground light-duty vehicles to ensure safe, reliable, and efficient operation. This role supports site operations by maintaining fleet availability and minimizing downtime.

Responsibilities:

- Perform inspections, diagnostics, maintenance, and repairs on light-duty vehicles.
- Maintain and repair fleet vehicles including Toyota trucks, personnel carriers, and support vehicles used underground.
- Complete preventive maintenance services (oil changes, brakes, steering, suspension, electrical systems).
- Diagnose mechanical and electrical faults using diagnostic tools and technical manuals.
- Perform repairs on gasoline and diesel engines, drivetrains, and hydraulic systems where applicable.
- Accurately complete work orders, including labour, parts, and failure reporting.
- Ensure all maintenance activities meet safety, environmental, and company standards.
- Identify and communicate equipment defects, safety concerns, and improvement opportunities.
- Maintain a clean, safe, and organized work area.
- Collaborate with supervisors, planners, and operators to prioritize and complete work efficiently.

Qualifications:

- Valid Automotive Service Technician (310S) Journeyperson certification or 310T or 421A.
- Minimum 3–5 years of experience maintaining light-duty vehicles; mining or industrial experience is an asset.
- Experience working on Toyota fleet vehicles preferred.
- Strong knowledge of automotive mechanical and electrical systems.
- Experience with diagnostic tools and vehicle electronics.
- Familiarity with maintenance management systems (e.g., SAP) is an asset.
- Strong troubleshooting and problem-solving skills.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Valid Ontario driver's licence.
- Ability to lift, carry, push, and pull 50 lbs or more.
- Frequent climbing, bending, kneeling, twisting, and overhead reaching during bolting activities.

- Ability to wear required PPE including respirators, hearing protection, fall protection, and other site-specific PPE.
- Ability to respond safely in emergency situations, including equipment shutdown and evacuation.
- Willingness and ability to work rotating day/night shift schedules — required..
